

Admission Policy for ME Courses

Admission in ME courses of this institution is done on the basis valid GATE Score card, if the GATE qualified candidates are not available then admission is done based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination.

A candidate seeking admission to ME Courses should have passed B.E./B.Tech. or equivalent examination approved by the AICTE in appropriate branch with at least 55% marks in the aggregate. Candidates belonging to SC/ST categories of the State of Madhya Pradesh will get relaxation as per the norms of State Government of Madhya Pradesh.

The counselling for admission is conducted by the Directorate of Technical Education, Government of Madhya Pradesh through online off campus procedure. Interested candidates may visit website www.dte.mponline.gov.in for details regarding admission rules and counselling process. Normally in the State of Madhya Pradesh counselling process starts in the months of May-June.

Reservation Policy

The Institute follows the reservation policy of the Technical Education & Skill Development Department of Government of Madhya Pradesh. According to the present policy 16%, 20% and 14% seats of the sanctioned intake is reserved for the candidates belonging to SC, ST and OBC (excluding creamy layer) categories, respectively, of Madhya Pradesh as notified by the state government.

In each category, i.e. Unreserved (UR), ST, SC and OBC (excluding creamy layer) 3% seats are reserved for candidates belonging to Physically Handicapped class. In each category and class 30% seats are reserved for female candidates.

Document Detention Policy

The Institute does not detain any document of the candidate other than the original Transfer Certificate (TC) of the institution in which candidate has last studied. At the time of admission candidates are required to bring all the relevant original documents in support of his eligibility for admission along with their photocopies. The original documents are verified and returned to the candidate on the same day.

Refund of fee on Cancellation of Admission

If a candidate gets his/her admission of 1st semester cancelled from the university or admission of an ineligible candidate is cancelled by the university, prior to 7 days before the last date of admission, as declared by the University, the tuition fee deposited by the candidate shall be refunded back to the candidate after deducting 10% from the deposited amount. After this date fee deposited by the candidate is not refundable.
